Specific public health measures to be taken in schools at Alert Level 2

- Parents are asked to keep any sick children at home. If a sick child comes to school, they will be sent home.
- Children, young people and staff should be far enough away from each other so
 that they are not breathing on or touching each other, coupled with good hygiene
 practices and regular cleaning of commonly touched surfaces. There does not
 need to be a specific measurement but where practicable 1m should be used as
 a guide, particularly between adults.
- Hand sanitiser at entry to class rooms and in shared spaces. Soap, water and
 the ability to dry hands must be provided in bathrooms. Due to concerns with
 sourcing ongoing supplies of hand sanitiser it would be great if children were able
 to bring their own personal supply to school.
- Where practicable ensure that children and young people regularly wash and dry hands, cough and sneeze into their elbow, and try to avoid touching their face.
- Physical education classes and break time activities can include access to sports equipment including playgrounds but hygiene practice should be observed after playing with equipment.
- Disinfect and clean all surfaces daily. (Teachers to support Dave in managing this)
- Contact tracing registers must be set up and identify which children and adults
 are on site, in each teaching space, including recording if there is a different
 composition of children and adults during the day. This includes recording visitors
 to the site, including parents.

Specific Protocols for OLV

- Level 2 is about being safe and sensible.
- Toilets will be cleaned twice daily.
- Classroom doors kept open as possible.
- No parents to enter cloakrooms/classrooms.
- One parent in the office at a time. Must sign the register.
- Teachers to use the back door to the office between 8:30-9:00am and 3:00 to
 3:30pm (would be sensible to avoid photocopying at these times)
- No assembly.
- Devices to be cleaned regularly.
- No students to enter school grounds before 8:30am bell.
- Only students and staff are to enter school beyond the cones on the court area.
- If you bring your children to school late you will need to call the office (3487790) and someone will come and collect the children from the coned off area on the court.
- At 2:55 parents to collect children from Rooms 10.11 and 12 from outside their classrooms.
- At 3:00pm all other children will wait on the court area to be collected by their parents who will enter the gate by Room 10 and leave via the gate by Room 1. Please remain behind the cones and your children will come to the gate.

Ensure you maintain social distancing and move as soon as your children are at the Room 1 Gate.

- Bus students will wait on Room the 8 veranda.
- St Thomas Boys collecting siblings to wait on field.
- Ensure social distancing in car park of 2 metres.
- No drinking fountains. Children bring their own drink bottle.
- A teacher aide to assist with morning tea and lunch duty. Duty teacher needs to be on time for start of duty.
- Wet Day Duty as follows: All teachers stay in own class for 20 minutes. Then
 duty will be split in half. Duty Teacher will be joined by 2 teacher's aides. They
 will be responsible for 3 rooms each. Rooms 6-8, Rooms 4,1 and 9, Rooms
 10-12.
- Teachers to be in class prior to all start times to manage entry to classroom.
- Distance learning only available to those who are self-isolating.
- Classroom teachers to manage any first aid requirements for their students.
- Children are not to enter the office area. All staff to respect the office bubble.
